



EU REACH Regulation 1907/2006: Substance Information according to Article 33

The EU Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) requires communication of information about certain substances in articles supplied on the Community market.

According to REACH article 33, suppliers have to inform about presence of a 'substance of very high concern' (SVHC) of the 'candidate list' for authorisation, if contained in articles and / or packaging materials in concentrations above 0.1% w/w.

According to article 59 (1, 10) of the Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH), an updated candidate list was published by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA): <http://echa.europa.eu/web/guest/candidate-list-table/>

With regard to the candidate list mentioned above, we inform:

The article **KENWOOD M-7000S-B** and its packaging materials
contain **no substances** of the current
candidate list (date 27.06.2024)
in a concentration above 0.1 % weight by weight.

When other substances of very high concern (SVHC) will be added to the candidate list for authorisation, we will do our best to obtain the relevant information as soon as possible from our suppliers of components and finished products.
